

2022 MAIN STREET REVITALIZATION PROGRAM:



BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT CATEGORY

This program provides funding of up to \$3,500 per business district to a Chamber of Commerce, Business Improvement District or Civic Association. A program grant is provided to reimburse expenditures for items including, but not limited to:

- Hanging planters/plants/flowers utilized within a Business District's open space
- Landscape modifications at Business District entrances with signage
- Planter boxes and plantings along public walkways
- Garden area/wood chip mulch
- Ornamental stone/pavers/gravel/painted boulders/decorative elements
- Benches and Seating

Pre-approval and proper proof of spending including receipts, paid invoices will be required for reimbursement. Funding is limited and available on a first come, first served basis. This program and funding is separate from the 2022 Chamber of Commerce Program and you may qualify for both. Marketing and promotional expenses do not qualify under this program. PSEG Long Island plaque/signage will be included in all projects.

Grants are designed to achieve one or more of the following benefits:

- To foster economic viability, vibrancy and support of local businesses.
- To increase economic growth and business in downtown areas that will benefit from beautification projects
