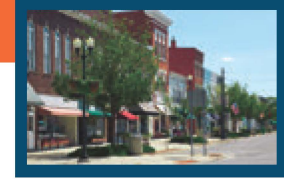
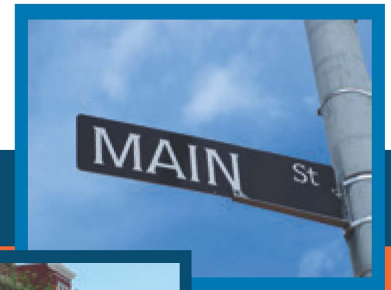


# 2022 MAIN STREET REVITALIZATION PROGRAM:

## CHAMBER OF COMMERCE CATEGORY



PSEG Long Island offers incentives to support the enhancement of outdoor spaces where local businesses will provide outdoor dining and commerce. The program provides funding of up to \$5,000 to a Chamber of Commerce or Business Improvement District. A program grant is provided to reimburse expenditures for items including, but not limited to, outdoor seating, outdoor tables, outdoor lighting, outdoor patio heaters, durable safety materials, limited amount of signage in support of outdoor dining/commerce, clothing racks, barricades and/or planter style barricades. Limited signage is defined as specifically related to outdoor commerce project(s) that support and encourage participation in business openings. Funding for signage is limited to 20% of total grant, up to \$1,000.

Pre-approval and proper proof of spending including receipts, paid invoices will be required for reimbursement. If you had an approved grant in 2021, you may submit a new application to request a 2022 grant.

Grants are designed to achieve one or more of the following benefits:

- To foster economic viability, vibrancy and support of local businesses.
- To increase economic growth and business in downtown areas that will be supported by a local Chamber of Commerce or Business Improvement District.
