

## 2026 PJM Request for Proposals

### Question & Answers

**Q1. What is LIPA's intention with ending the service term on October 31, 2039? Currently PJM capacity auctions' tenor covers the demand year (June 1 – May 31st) so this structure wouldn't allow the project to participate in the 2039/2040 BRA/IA's without having a mismatched capacity position from Nov – May. Is it possible for the project to submit a proposal with a service end date of May 31, 2040 so the project can avoid this issue?**

**A1: LIPA chose October 31, 2039 as the contract end date as that date aligns with the NYISO's Summer Capability Period for 2039. Under existing New York law, LIPA believes it is prohibited from purchasing power from fossil fueled resources after 1-1-2040. Therefore, we will not accept a Proposal with a service term end date that is different than October 31, 2039.**

**Q2. Do all of the certifications/forms that were previously executed and submitted into the last RFP need to re-signed and dated for the current RFP?**

**A2: Yes.**
