RFI Background and Goals

- PSEG Long Island, as agent for and on behalf of the Long Island Power Authority (“LIPA”), submitted comments in response to the order issued by the New York State Public Service Commission (“PSC”) on December 18, 2025.
- PSEG Long Island has several in-flight actions to address near-term needs as well as proactive planning measures to address anticipated future needs and support the continued provision of safe, reliable, and affordable service to LIPA’s customers on Long Island.
- To address these emerging needs, PSEG Long Island is issuing this Request for Information (“RFI”) to seek potential solutions that may address needs through 2035. The RFI will solicit responses from providers of clean and non-emitting solutions, including, but not limited to: demand side management, energy storage, distributed energy resources, and other non-emitting generation resources.

Overview

The objective of this RFI is to gather information and input from interested parties to assist LIPA and PSEG Long Island in determining the extent to which renewables and non-emitting energy resources can be secured to assist LIPA in meeting its resource requirements with a focus on managing system peak demand.

These resources include:

- Large-Scale Solar + Energy Storage and Wind Generation + Energy Storage
- Virtual Power Plant (“VPP”)
- Energy Efficiency (“EE”)
- Demand Response (“DR”)
- Distributed Energy Resources (“DER”)
- Other Non-Emitting Generation Resources

RFI Structure

RFI requests data in four sections:

1) **Organizational Background and Experience** - This section is intended to help LIPA understand the Respondent's experience and overall background.

2) **Technical Overview** - The goal of this section is to gather general information regarding the various qualifying technologies and/or solutions that can potentially support the LIPA system.

3) **Technical Implementation** - This section requests the specific information developers will need to deploy the proposed qualifying technologies and/or solutions in the LIPA system, and their effective costs and benefits.

4) **Proposed Procurement Schedule** - This section seeks feedback from Respondents on the schedule for developing quality proposals in response to an RFP and the timeline for developing proposed projects.

Appendix A - RFI Questions for Specific Technologies

- PSEG Long Island formulated a series of questions for each technology based on our experience with previous renewable procurements.
- The purpose of these questions is for PSEG Long Island to better understand the needs of Clean Energy professionals that may offer Proposals in follow up procurements.
- Knowing these needs can greatly enhance the ability of PSEG Long Island to develop well informed and supportive procurements that will lead to beneficial projects for LIPA's Ratepayers.
