RE: 2022 Home Comfort and Home Performance Programs Application Version 2.0 Release

## Dear Home Comfort Partners:

PSEG Long Island is pleased to announce the 2022 Home Comfort and Home Performance v2.0 rebate application workbook. These changes are effective Monday, May 16<sup>th</sup>. All new project submittals must use the v2.0 application workbook after Friday, May 27<sup>th</sup>. The application workbook is now available for download at:

We have made significant changes to simplify our Home Comfort program and requirements. These changes are designed to simplify processing of applications and increase the number of eligible cold climate ASHP models. Coupled with higher rebates, we expect this will allow more customers to participate in the program. Qualifying cold climate ASHPs are eligible for \$1,000/12,000 heating BTU @ 17°F (or \$5,500/12,000 heating BTU @ 17°F for income eligible (LMI) customers) regardless of existing fuel type for whole house projects. Cold climate ASHPs only need to be listed on the NEEP ccASHP list. There are no longer requirements of 17 SEER or 18 SEER (for ducted or for ductless ASHP) and HSPF of 10. However, preapprovals and Manual J calculations are still required.

Non cold climate ASHPs are no longer eligible for partial house rebates. Qualifying cold climate ASHP's are still eligible for \$375/12,000 heating BTU @ 17°F for ducted systems (or \$350/12,000 heating BTU @ 17°F for ductless systems) regardless of existing fuel type for partial house project. Cold climate ASHPs only need to be listed on the NEEP ccASHP list. There are no longer requirements of 17 SEER or 18 SEER (for ducted or for ductless ASHP) and HSPF of 10. However, preapprovals and Manual J calculations are still required.

To be eligible to extend these robust rebates to income eligible customers, Home Comfort Partners need to enroll directly with Energy Finance Solutions (EFS)/Slipstream to extend LMI rebates to income eligible customers and provide potential financing options for eligible projects with the NYSERDA Green Jobs – Green New York funding.
