

CEP Program Announcement 2017-05: Combined Heat and Power (CHP) Workbook, FAQs and PCC Version 2.0

Dear Energy Efficiency Program Participant,

Combined Heat and Power (CHP) Workbook, FAQs and PCC Version 2.0

- CHP version 2.0 program documents - the PSEG Long Island CHP workbook, FAQs and PCC – are effective starting Thursday (07/13/2017). These documents will be available on the website for download within the next several business days. Changes are reflected below:
 - CHP rebates have been reduced. New rebate table can be found in the CHP workbook.
 - Minimum allowable system size has been limited to 50 kW.

- Replacement of existing non-operational CHP units will now be handled on a case by case basis.

Any complete project submittals - includes all supporting documents as per the CHP required documents check sheet - received prior to 5:00pm on Wednesday 07/12/2017 will be preapproved at version 1.0 rebate values.

- Any new project submittals received after 5:00 pm on 07/12/17 will be paid under version 2.0 rebate values.
- Any incomplete project submittals will be paid under version 2.0 rebate values.
- All project submittals must be emailed to the CEP mailbox cepli@pseg.com. Any emails directed to CEP staff members may not be accepted.
- Any complete project submittals previously received by the CEP mailbox and not yet processed will be paid at version 1.0 rebate levels.

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- Any project that is not preapproved because products do not qualify, project submittals were incomplete, pre-inspection identifies different conditions, where a scope has changed, or where another discrepancy was identified will be paid at version 2.0 rebate values.
