

+50% by 2032


- There is a recognized need to support existing customer load, increase reliability and plan for future load growth
- The transmission lines will also contribute to the development of a robust and adaptable grid to facilitate renewable technologies

What are the benefits of both of these projects?


- Ensure reliable electric service for the Rockaways
- Address current and future load growth needs
- Enhance ability to provide uninterrupted service during extreme weather like heat waves or storms
- Relieve load and capacity challenges on surrounding substations while providing increased contingency capacity for the area
- Increase electric capacity in the area to allow for routine and necessary system maintenance

Timeline

June 2023 - November 2023

- Construction along the route
- Final restoration work

December 2023 – February 2024

- Connect equipment at the substation
- Test and energize equipment at the substation
