

Make Ready Data Aggregator Notice

We are reaching out to inform you that PSEG Long Island and EnergyHub have mutually agreed to conclude their data aggregation services, effective, April 30, 2026. EnergyHub works with Network Charging Providers (NCPs) to collect data from EV charging stations installed through the EV Make Ready and Fleet Make Ready programs. EnergyHub is working with the NCPs to collect any remaining charging session data through February 28, 2026. No action is required from you at this time, unless your NCP contacts you regarding your EV charging station.

PSEG Long Island has used this data to gain insights into charger utilization and grid impacts and will be exploring alternative solutions to continue these insights moving forward. As part of the EV Make Ready and Fleet Make Ready Program Terms and Conditions, applicants are required to provide data for the installed EV chargers for a minimum of five (5) years in exchange for receiving incentives. Depending on when your EV charging station was installed, you may have already satisfied this requirement. If so, no further action is needed at this time.

For applicants who have not met this five (5) year minimum timeline, PSEG Long Island will not hold applicants accountable for providing charging session data during this transition period. However, PSEG Long Island may periodically request any charging data that is available from your NCP. Moving forward, quarterly data requests may be sent to the following program email addresses depending on your program participation:

For future installations, eligible chargers must be selected from the PSEG Long Island Eligible Chargers List, which is available under the 'Program Resources' on the EV Make Ready and Fleet Make Ready webpages. This list is not expected to be updated for the foreseeable future. Should you have an EV charger you would like to use that is currently not on the list, please reach out to us to discuss further. For project closeouts, we will still ask applicants to provide the serial number(s) associated with each charger being installed, which is provided in the Site Inspection Checklist form.

We appreciate your partnership in these programs and will work to ensure that this transition is as smooth as possible.
