RE: 2019 Geothermal Application Release

Dear Cool Homes Partners:

We are excited to announce that the 2019 Geothermal Rebate Application form is now available. The Geothermal application is located at https://www.psegliny.com/saveenergyandmoney/solarrenewableenergy/geothermal. PSEG Long Island will continue to accept 2018 geothermal applications through January 11, 2019. We will not accept applications from prior years.

The rebate levels and efficiency requirements remain the same for 2019. We have modified the application to improve the handling of dual stage ground source heat pump equipment to incorporate both part load and full load performance.
