RE: 2020 Home Comfort and Home Performance Rebate Application Version 1.3 Release and Geothermal Rebate Application Version 1.1 Release

Dear Home Comfort Partners:

PSEG Long Island is excited to announce the 2020 Home Comfort and Home Performance Rebate Application Version 1.3 release <u>and</u> the 2020 Geothermal Rebate Application Version 1.1 release. Effective immediately, all Home Comfort and Geothermal Partners are required to submit new projects using the new applications.

The quarterly release of applications is part of the program evolution designed to support PSEG Long Island's commitment to New York State heat pump goals which are considered the most aggressive clean energy and climate agenda in the country. In 2019, NYS passed the nation-leading Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act (Climate Act) to empower every New Yorker to fight climate change at home, at work, and in their communities.

Remember that all 2020 Home Comfort rebate applications require preapproval prior to installation. We recommend you submit the application for preapproval shortly after you receive a deposit from the customer. If you complete a project before a preapproval is granted, you will not receive a rebate or contractor incentive for that project. Continued noncompliance with this requirement will result in the inability to offer PSEG Long Island Home Comfort rebates to your customers.

To deliver timely project preapprovals for submitted rebate applications, we request that you continue to include photos with your preapproval submissions, for both partial and whole house projects. This will allow our Home Comfort team to verify project details required to issue timely preapprovals. Otherwise remote and/or onsite verifications are required that cause delays with preapprovals.

For partial house projects with ccASHP and non-ccASHP, ccASHP should be listed as the first system on the worksheet for the contractor to be eligible for the higher ccASHP contractor incentive level.

Completion documents (including Project Completion Form and Invoice) must be submitted in a timely matter (two week) for customers to receive their rebates in 60-90 days of the completion document submission.
