Are there rate incentives for using a heat pump? Yes! If the heat pump is the primary source of heat for a home, customers are eligible for a **Residential Electric Heating Rate** (580) from PSEG Long Island. From October through May, this rate provides a 40% energy delivery charge discount for all usage above 400k Wh/month. **Visit** PSEG Long Island to learn more about current electric rates.

FEDERAL ENERGY SAVINGS YOU CAN CLAIM BEFORE 2025 ENDS



Homeowners can claim up to \$3,200 in federal tax credits for energy-efficient upgrades through December 31, 2025, under the Inflation Reduction Act. The Energy Efficient Home Improvement Credit covers 30% of

eligible costs, up to \$1,200 for insulation and electrical upgrades. Plus,\$2,000 for heat pumps and heat pump water heaters. The **Residential Clean Energy Credit** offers 30% back on systems like geothermal heat pumps and battery storage. All items must be placed in service by the deadline. You must have a tax bill to benefit, which may not be the case for certain low-income households.

\$5.36 BILLION TOWARD A MORE EFFICIENT AND EQUITABLE NEW YORK





New York's Bold **2026–2030 Energy Efficiency & Building Electrification Plan**. In May 2025, the New York Public Service Commission approved \$5.36 billion in new efficiency and electrification portfolios to deliver lifetime savings of 615 trillion BTUs (equivalent). An estimated \$1.6 billion is dedicated to low to moderate income households. The plan shifts from traditional rebates to weatherization and building envelope upgrades, introduces a Strategic Framework for deeper, longer-term impacts, and replaces utility performance incentives with stronger regulatory oversight. New York's focus is on equitable building improvements that advance its clean energy and climate goals.
